### Gymnastics

- Our Xcel Bronze, Silver and Gold teams went to AAU State Meet on April 30 - May 1 in Carrollton, GA.
- Several gymnast won 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> places
- We had showcase for Recreational Gymnastics program on May 7<sup>th</sup>.
- Our last competition of the season will be the AAU Southern Regionals Championship on May 21-22 at Ocean Center in Daytona Beach, FL.

### Athletics

- Athletics has finished the 2022 baseball-softball season. All-star teams have been selected and are preparing for the district meets that will be held in Coffee County and Wayne County.
- The track state tournament was held in Jefferson, GA on May 6-7 and the CCPSA won the overall meet with a score of 488 – men and 268 – women; 17 athletes won 1<sup>st</sup> place, 17 came in 2<sup>nd</sup> place, and 11 came in 3<sup>rd</sup> place.
- Adult softball currently has 10 teams registered and will begin games in June
- Volleyball is also starting and had 100 participants.

### Aquatics

- A new head swim coach has been hired for the swim team.
- The first swim meet will be held June 6<sup>th</sup>
- Swim lessons filled up quickly; all morning sessions are currently full so we are now offering evening sessions.
- Swim instructors will be certified under a program called “Starfish” that will help instructors to be better prepared to teach participants how to swim
- We are still searching for lifeguards and have added another lifeguard certification course to help. The pretest will be May 27<sup>th</sup> and the final exam will be June 4<sup>th</sup>.
